Administrators for estate approved in Butler County, Ohio, 18 July 1831

A history of early settlers of Rowan County by Eugene Bean says that Frederick was in Rowan in 1789. Land records in the county indicate that he purchased 120 acres along the bank of Cold Water Creek from Samuel Wood on 30 September 1790 (LDS film # 007640166, Inferior Court record, p. 81). This property was sold in 1815 when the family migrated to Ohio.

Mary SLOUGH

Friedrich SHOLLENBARGER purchased 120 acres "lying on Cold Water Creek" in Rowan County, North Carolina, on 30 September 1790. He sold this parcel on 8 September 1815 (Rowan County Deed books 12, p. 170 and 20, p. 553).

Friedrich SHOLLENBARGER purchased 100 acres in Butler County, Ross Township, sec. 11, 27 November 1815; Book F, page 144.

Mary still survived in August, 1831, according to probate records.

Inventory of property for probate in Butler County, Ohio, was filed 24 October 1831 (Inventories, book 3, p. 131).
